To make it tricky see if your grown up can cover one group and see if you can complete the sum i.e. $\text{_____} + 12 =$

Write a letter to your parents to try and persuade them to let you have an elephant as a pet. How would you look after the elephant? How would you overcome any problems? What fun things could you do? Don't forget to start your letter with Dear...

Using youtube see if you can listen to three stories from CBBC Jackanory Junior. Just make sure your grown up checks the story link first. Remember to stay safe on the internet.

Write a list of adjectives to describe a tiger. Think of how it moves, what sounds it makes as well as what it looks like. Can you write descriptive sentences? I.e. The fierce tiger crept slowly across the dusty floor. If that is a bit tricky see if you can write a sentence using two adjectives i.e. The angry and mean tiger.
