


Remember some of these activities can be done over a few days. Some things may need revisited a few days later.

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Change y to I, then add ed • Take off e, then add ed • If second last letter is a vowel, double consonant, then add ed. • Irregular - some words do not end in -ed e.g. run - ran. 	<p>are winning.
