PROVISIONAL DATA

Well done to all the Year 6 children who worked so hard all year to achieve their absolute best!

Are this year's SATS results better than previous years at All Saints?

No school is able to compare this year's results with previous years due to the huge changes in National Curriculum since 2014. These are the first set of results that record the success of the children learning the objectives from the new curriculum. Nationally this year the difficulty of the tests has been raised.

How does All Saints compare to the national trends?

Early indications of the national trends when compared to All Saints are as follows. The percentage of children attaining the national expectation are subject to change once appeals for re-marking have been completed.
