Space Bandits is a great new comic written by Mark Millar, with art is by Matteo Scalera and colours that are by Marcelo Maiolo. It is published by Image Comics with help from Netflix. It opens with a robbery aboard a space ship planned by a woman called Cody Blue, a cunning mastermind with a good heart; but instead of speed or flight, smarts are her superpowers. Another woman, who is also up to no good, is introduced; Thena Khole, who is quick-witted, smart and extremely dangerous.

Mark Millar, the writer of *Space Bandits*, has written such things as *Ultimates* (the basis for the *Avengers Assemble* movie) and Matteo Scalera (the artist) has a very distinct art style (similar to the works of Ian Gibson and Cam Kennedy). Matteo Scalera has illustrated such things as *Indestructible Hulk* and *Secret Avengers*.

The two main characters are strong, independent women and the comic shows women can be better than men.
