Re' Hairstyles

I thought it might be useful to provide clarification on what is and is not permissible in relation to hairstyles.

Extreme hairstyles are not acceptable for boys, this means no shaved, carved, patterned, logos or Mohawk/Mohican styles or hair shaved to the scalp. All of these styles set children apart and draw attention for all the wrong reasons. Boy's and girl's hair should be un-dyed. Any issues of medical or religious nature can of course be discussed on a one to one with me in confidence. For girls, keeping hair free of the face (i.e. in a ponytail, bun etc.) seems sensible, especially in the current warm weather, head lice are also less likely to spread! Hairbands, bows etc. are fine but again, should not be so noticeable as to cause distraction to the wearer or her classmates (believe me, it has happened).
